On October 8, 1871, two of the most destructive fires in all of U.S. history devastated the areas of Peshtigo, WI and Chicago, IL. 1.5 million acres of land was ravaged, houses were destroyed, and well over a thousand lives were lost that day. Imagine being trapped in one of those fires or even just witnessing those catastrophic events. Reading through accounts of the day, it's hard not to get chills at the damage caused. And all of this started with just two little flames. But the fires quickly grew, taking advantage of dry conditions, environments that allowed it to grow, and the carelessness of people not watching closely. Think of how many lives could have been saved by stopping those flames from starting.

Flames can be dangerous in churches too and not just flames of the physical sort. The writer James compares our tongue to a flame of fire, able to cause damage at a rapid rate. It can destroy lives with only a few words of malicious intent. Unfortunately, it happens too often even among Christians. The fire of ruthless criticism burns those trying their best, while those criticizing refuse to lift a finger to help. Gossip, whether true or false, spreads like wildfire, ruining reputations wherever it goes. And relationships become strained by the words that often come from our lips. Our tongues might just be the most dangerous part of our bodies.

At the same time, the new creation in us helps us combat these flames as firefighters of faith. The Holy Spirit works within us to douse the fires. The Word helps us to spread the truth in love to the survivors. God has given you the power and strength to put out the fire of angry words before saying them. He also offers forgiveness for all the times our tongues have caused damage. Just as importantly, he gives us the power to rebuild.

James 3:6 - The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.


### **School News**

#### **Registration for Preschool Next School Year**

Preschool classes are almost full. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. You have the choice of which days you would like your child to come. There's a minimum attendance of 3 half days up to 5 full days. The cost is \$30 for half day, \$40 for a full day. Tours will be scheduled individually for those interested. The School Board approved a program that gives an incentive to recruiting new families for our school. A church family who refers a new family will receive a \$200 script gift card also at Christmas per family if they so choose. There is no limit to the number of families you can refer. Have you checked out the ShopWithSCRIP.com website? You can now order your own SCRIP any time, anywhere you need it. You can also now order with your credit card! All you have to do is login and sign up! If you have students at Salem, the rebates earned can be applied to your child's tuition. There will be a flat 5% fee on all orders. This will cover the shipping and administrative fees involved in the orders. You can also apply your profits to your child's lunch account as well as tuition.
