Holy Trinity Sunday

God in Three Persons, Blessed Trinity

Welcome! Thank you for joining us for worship today. In our services we gather before our almighty God to receive his gifts and to offer him our worship and praise. Through God's powerful Word and sacraments he renews our faith and strengthens us to serve in joy.

PRAYER BEFORE WORSHIP: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, united in will and work, we praise you for your grace and mercy. Thank you for revealing to us your plan of salvation. Fill our hearts as we worship today with peace and hope. Amen.

THEME OF THE DAY: In the first half of the Church Year (Advent through Pentecost) we look at the life of Christ. In the second half of the year, we look at the teachings of Christ. We begin with one of the greatest mysteries: God is triune.

In the first chapter of the Bible we read, "Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image..." (Genesis 1:26). Note the singular "God" and the plural "us." Scripture teaches us that there is only one God but that he exists as three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is triune (three-in-one). This teaching is not some logical exercise or philosophical excursion. The doctrine of the Trinity is central to our salvation. The triune God is our Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. Lose this doctrine, and as the Athanasian Creed says, you lose it all. A Jesus who is less than God is also less than a Savior.

ABOUT THE ATHANASIAN CREED: While we use a creed in worship most weeks, the Christian church reserves the Athanasian Creed for Trinity Sunday. This creed is one of the three confessional creeds of the Christian Church. While its exact author and origin are unknown, it was written in the 5th or 6th century to defend two main truths of the Bible. The creed teaches the Holy Trinity, that God is revealed in Scripture as three distinct Persons yet one God. The creed also affirms the dual nature of Jesus as true God and true Man.

The name Athanasian was attached to the Creed in later history, bringing to mind St. Athanasius, a staunch defender of both these doctrines. We speak only part of the Creed in worship. Find the full text and a more detailed description of this special statement of faith in the hymnal on pages 284-285.

I deserve your punishment both now and forever.


But Jesus, my Savior, paid for my sins


with his innocent suffering and death.

¹²Greet one another with a holy kiss. ¹³All God's people here send their greetings.

¹⁴May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

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

Athanasian Creed

This creed is named after St. Athanasius, a staunch defender of the Christian faith in the fourth century. It was prepared to assist the Church in combating two errors that undermined Bible teaching. One error denied that God's Son and the Holy Spirit are of one being or Godhead with the Father. The other error denied that Jesus Christ is true God and true man in one person. Learn more about this creed on the first page of the bulletin and in the hymnal.

Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all else, hold to the true Christian faith.

Whoever does not keep this faith pure in all points will certainly perish forever.

Now this is the true Christian faith:

We worship one God in three persons and three persons in one God, without mixing the persons or dividing the divine being.

For each person – The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit – is distinct, but the deity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory and coeternal in majesty.

What the Father is, so is the Son, and so is the Holy Spirit.

The Father is uncreated, the Son uncreated, the Holy Spirit uncreated;

the Father is infinite, the Son infinite, the Holy Spirit infinite;

the Father is eternal, the Son eternal, the Holy Spirit eternal;

yet they are not three who are eternal, but there is one who is eternal, just as they are not three who are uncreated, nor three who are infinite, but there is one who is uncreated and one who is infinite.

In the same way the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, the Holy Spirit is almighty; yet they are not three who are almighty, but there is one who is almighty.

So the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God; yet they are not three Gods, but one God.

So the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord; yet they are not three Lords, but one Lord.

For just as Christian truth compels us to confess each person individually to be God and Lord, so the true Christian faith forbids us to speak of three Gods or three Lords.

The Father is neither made nor created nor begotten of anyone.

The Son is neither made nor created, but is begotten of the Father alone.

The Holy Spirit is neither made nor created, nor begotten, but proceeds from the Father and the Son.

So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.

And within this Trinity none comes before or after; none is greater or inferior, but all three persons are coequal and coeternal, so that, in every way, as stated before, all three persons are to be worshipped as one God, and one God worshipped as three persons.

Whoever wishes to be saved must have this conviction of the Trinity.

Please stand.


