#### **Seventh Sunday After Pentecost**

Meaningful Ministry--Not Glee and Gratitude, but Rejection and Resentment

Welcome! Thank you for joining us for worship today. In our services we gather before our almighty God to receive his gifts and to offer him our worship and praise. Through God's powerful Word and sacraments he renews our faith and strengthens us to serve in joy.

**PRAYER BEFORE WORSHIP:** Holy Spirit, you are the quiet servant who calls us to faith, enlightens us with your gifts, and sanctifies us for holy living. Lead us to lives of humble service that we may glorify God in all we do. Amen.

**THEME OF THE DAY:** If ministry involves serving others with love and compassion, you would think that people would respond only with glee and gratitude for the help they receive. Sometimes, but not always. When our ministry efforts are met with rejection and resentment, we are in good company. The prophets, apostles, and even Jesus himself all had people respond negatively to their ministries. When that happens to us, it doesn't mean our ministry is no longer meaningful. Even if others do not appreciate our efforts to serve them, God still appreciates our efforts to serve him.

Our Worship Series: Ministry comes from the Latin word for "service." Ministry involves serving others with love, compassion, and empathy. Helping someone with physical needs is sometimes called "compassion ministry." Helping someone with their spiritual needs, sharing the good news of Christ, is generally called "gospel ministry." We misunderstand ministry if we think of it as something only pastors do. Ultimately every believer is called by God to reflect Christ-like love and share the message of salvation as God provides those opportunities. In this worship series we will see our efforts to meet the needs of those God brings into our sphere of influence as meaningful ministry. In our service to them, those people see God's love and God sees our faith. Our worship follows this pattern:

7/7 Ministry not with glee and gratitude, but rejection & resentment

7/14 Meaningful Ministry: Sent with God's own authority

7/21 Meaningful Ministry: Jesus models a compassionate shepherd's heart

7/28 Meaningful Ministry: God meets our needs to meet others' needs

8//4 Meaningful Ministry: Fear not, for the Lord is with you



## **CONFESSION & FORGIVENESS OF SINS**



First Reading Ezekiel 2:1-7

The Lord sends Ezekiel to prophesy to the Israelites, knowing that most will not be grateful for the prophet's message but resentful.

<sup>1</sup>He said to me, "Son of man, stand up on your feet and I will speak to you." <sup>2</sup>As he spoke, the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.


<sup>3</sup>He said: "Son of man, I am sending you to the Israelites, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against me; they and their ancestors have been in revolt against me to this very day. <sup>4</sup>The people to whom I am sending you are obstinate and stubborn. Say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says.' <sup>5</sup>And whether they listen or fail to listen—for they are a rebellious people—they will know that a prophet has been among them. <sup>6</sup>And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them or their words. Do not be afraid, though briers and thorns are all around you and you live among scorpions. Do not be afraid of what they say or be terrified by them, though they are a rebellious people. <sup>7</sup>You must speak my words to them, whether they listen or fail to listen, for they are rebellious.

## **Second Reading**

2 Timothy 2:1-13

St. Paul's ministry resulted in him being chained like a criminal. Yet God's Word cannot be chained.

<sup>1</sup>You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup>And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others. <sup>3</sup>Join with me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. <sup>4</sup>No one serving as a soldier gets entangled in civilian affairs, but rather tries to please his commanding officer. <sup>5</sup>Similarly, anyone who competes as an athlete does not receive the victor's crown except by competing according to the rules. <sup>6</sup>The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. <sup>7</sup>Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this.

<sup>8</sup>Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, <sup>9</sup>for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. <sup>10</sup>Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.

<sup>11</sup>Here is a trustworthy saying:

If we died with him,
we will also live with him;

12 if we endure,
we will also reign with him.

If we disown him,
he will also disown us;

13 if we are faithless,
he remains faithful,
for he cannot disown himself.

Gospel Mark 6:1-6

Many in Jesus' hometown rejected his ministry.

<sup>1</sup>Jesus left there and went to his hometown, accompanied by his disciples. <sup>2</sup>When the Sabbath came, he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed.

"Where did this man get these things?" they asked. "What's this wisdom that has been given him? What are these remarkable miracles he is performing? "Isn't this the carpenter? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas and Simon? Aren't his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him.

<sup>4</sup>Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own town, among his relatives and in his own home." <sup>5</sup>He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. <sup>6</sup>He was amazed at their lack of faith.

Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village.




## **Prayer of the Church**
