**THEME OF THE DAY:** The Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) celebrates its 175th anniversary in 2025 under the theme "Christ Through Us." WELS began with one seminary in 1865, started its first world mission in 1893, and celebrated its centennial in 1965 with 800 congregations, mostly in the Midwest. Today we see how Christ has worked through his good news of salvation in Word and sacraments to move this body of believers to support a Scripture-based ministerial education system, world missions in 45 countries, and more than 1,200 congregations across the United States.

The "Christ Through Us" theme informs the work of WELS to proclaim our Savior's love in our homes, churches, communities, and world. Our anniversary celebration fits well into our "Welcome Home" series as we remember that this family of faith is broader than one individual congregation, and enduring for generation to generation as Christ works in us and through us.

Deuteronomy 6:1-9

The Lord speaks his Word to our children and grandchildren through us.

<sup>1</sup>These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess, <sup>2</sup>so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life. <sup>3</sup>Hear, Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, promised you.

<sup>4</sup>Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. <sup>5</sup>Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup>These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. <sup>7</sup>Impress them on your children. 
### **Psalm of the Day: Enter His Gates with Thanksgiving** Psalm 100A


