Read again Deuteronomy 6:1-3 and summarize these verses in your own wording. What is the main point being made here? Why?

Deuteronomy 6:4 is the favorite, most quoted Bible passage among Jews. It's their John 3:16 passage. What makes this verse so appealing to those of the Jewish faith?

The Jewish religious leaders took verses 8-9 literally. They bound their arms with leather and tied small boxes to their foreheads with scripture in them. Google search some picture examples of this. They misapplied the truth of God's Word. What passages of the Bible are commonly misapplied or twisted today?

INTO MY LIFE

What spiritual quality do you think is the most important for children today to learn and display in their lives? Why is that so important?
