Upcoming Culver's Night

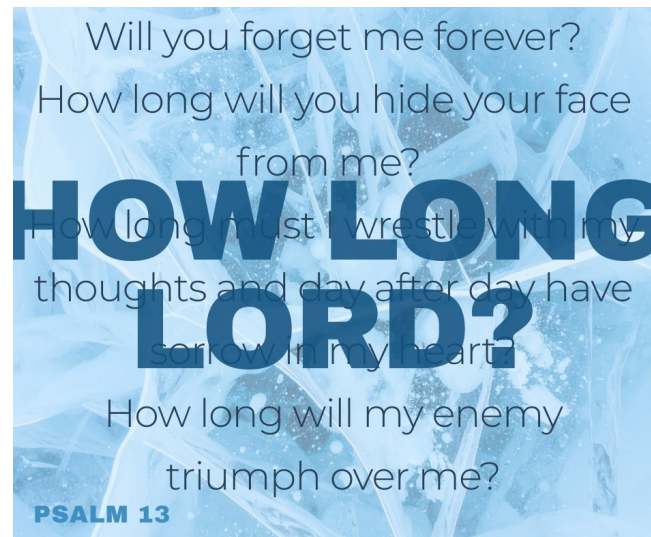
