Table Talk: Made to Move— God's Design in Learning

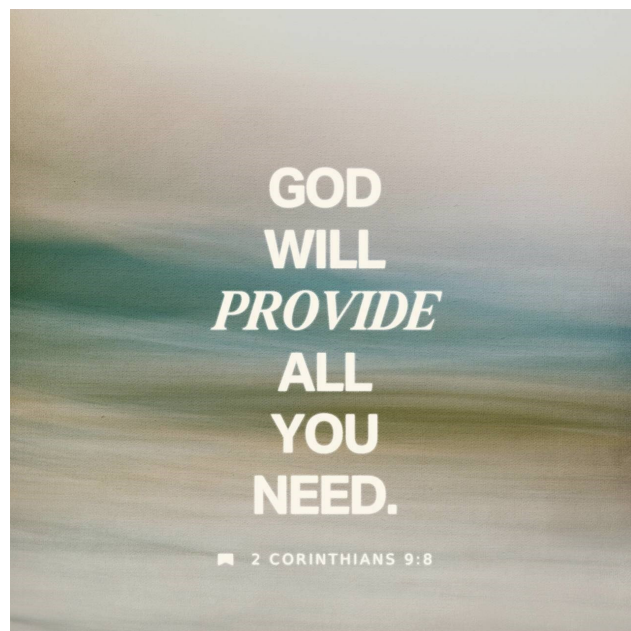

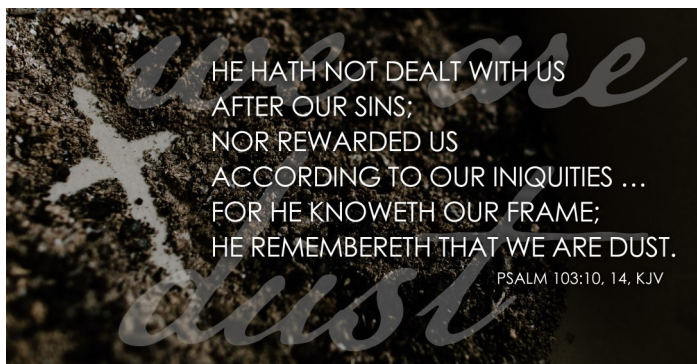
